The "Revenue Report" provides preliminary tabulations of cash receipts from state revenue sources. It reports both monthly and year-to-date collections for Michigan's six largest revenue-producing taxes. Since October was the first month of Michigan's 1984-85 fiscal year, the monthly and cumulative (year-to-date) figures shown below are the same.

Previously, the "Revenue Report" included escheats and investment income in the category "All Other Taxes and Fees." However, because the state credits escheats on an annual basis and investment earnings on a quarterly basis, inclusion of these amounts in a monthly report tends to distort the comparison between current collections and those for the same period during the last fiscal year. To make the figures in the table as comparable as possible, this and successive reports will exclude escheats and investment income from "All Other Taxes and Fees" and "Total Net Collections," reporting this information instead in a footnote to the table.
